

Purpose

1. Education New Zealand's (ENZ's) quarterly report for 1 April to 30 June 2023 is attached for your information.

Background

- 2. The quarterly report provides an overview of ENZ's fourth quarter performance for 2022/23. This quarterly report reflects ENZ's strategic four-year plan and aligns with the *New Zealand International Education Strategy 2022-2030* (NZIES).
- 3. ENZ's performance is assessed against ENZ's *Statement of Intent* 2022-2026, *Statement of Performance Expectations* 2022/23, ENZ's Business Plan 2022/23 and the Minister's Letter of Expectations. Performance is reported against the following strategic objectives:
 - **Tono/invitation:** Aotearoa New Zealand's unique education offerings and services are highly sought after by international learners
 - Pono/integrity: Aotearoa New Zealand delivers high-quality and diverse education experiences that are sustainable, globally competitive and deliver value to all involved
 - Hono/global connections: Aotearoa New Zealand makes the best possible use of its international education expertise to improve educational outcomes, establish partnerships and grow global connections
 - **Kono/nourishers:** ENZ's core capabilities nourish the organisation and support the delivery of all Strategic Objectives under the Four-year plan.
- 4. The report was not provided to ENZ's monitoring agencies (Ministry of Education and Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment) for consideration. They have indicated to ENZ that they will provide advice to you on ENZ's 2022/23 Annual Report, which will incorporate the information contained in this report.
- 5. ENZ's Board reviewed the quarterly report at its August 2023 meeting and requested changes. They approved providing the report to you on 29 September 2023.
- 6. Of ENZ's nine impact measures for 2022/23, eight have been achieved.
- 7. Of the seven performance measures that were outlined in ENZ's Statement of Performance Expectations 2022/23, three were achieved and one target is being finalised for full reporting in ENZ's Annual Report 2022/23.
- 8. The report also includes two measures under organisational capability.

Next steps

 The quarterly report contains the unaudited results for 2022/23. Audit New Zealand started its year end audit of ENZ on 2 October 2023. The audited results for 2022/23 will be included in the Annual Report 2022/23, which will be provided to you following final approval from Audit New Zealand.
