Prime Minister's Scholarships for Asia – Group Awardees: PMSA 2018 -19 Round 2



Lincoln University	Asian Agribusiness Summer School: China	15 candidates to undertake a programme studying Chinese language, culture, economy and institutional system. Students will be introduced to industry groups, including New Zealand and Chinese exporters in key agribusiness markets through field trips and business visits. Field trips will cover different parts of the supply chain, exposing students to small and large agricultural producers, food processors and retail.
Massey University	Bridging NZ and China	10 candidates to undertake a 6-week language learning and business experience at Peking University, Beijing, China.
University of Auckland	1+8 Consortia Programme with Pagoda Projects - Greater China	15 candidates will undertake this multi-city, '1 + 8 week' programme developed as a collaboration between the Universities of Auckland, Otago and Waikato, alongside Pagoda Projects Ltd. It consists of a guided week-long group project followed by an eight-week internship and focuses on language, culture and work-integrated learning spread across three destinations in mainland China and Taipei. With each city offering its own unique theme, the project aims to strengthen institutional relationships between New Zealand and Greater China whilst students enhance their international awareness, employability and language skills.
University of Canterbury	MGMT228 study tour to China	15 candidates to undertake a 6-week unique in-country cultural immersion and experiential learning opportunity in China. Students will study at Zhejiang Gongshang University. MGMT focuses on Chinese business practices and culture. Students participate in lectures and a second language promotion programme (SLPP) at Zhejiang Gongshang University in Hangzhou for three weeks, followed by 2 1/2 weeks of extensive business and cultural visits in Shanghai and Beijing. The learning outcomes focus on conducting business in China, with a specific focus on new export opportunity identification and development.
Massey University	Sustainable Fashion and Textile programme, New Delhi, India	8 Fashion / Textile Design students, and Creative Media Production students will undertake an 8-week study of sustainable fashion in India, as well as undertake collaborative projects with Fashion students in Indian fashion design programmes. NZ students will study Indian design influences, and production methods with artisans, designers and industry. Students from India and NZ will collaborate to explore solutions to issues identified in the unsustainable fashion supply chain. A documentary film of this Indian study-tour will be made, capturing the growing connections between NZ and India in education and industry, and improving international understanding of NZ tertiary education.
Te Whare Wānanga o Awanuiarangi	Indigenous Health and Entrepreneurship Opportunities – Ayurveda and Rongoa Māori	10 candidates will undertake a 6-week multi-disciplinary exploration of the growth and strength of Ayurveda in India –a traditional cultural practice which co-exists comfortably and successfully alongside the "western" medical model – and will give rise to insights that will support the resurgence of Rongoa Maori in New Zealand, not only for Maori people but for all New Zealanders.
University of Auckland	Reimagining India Programme	15 candidates will undertake a 4-week programme beginning with one week in Bangalore, then two weeks of experiential learning in Delhi, Jaipur and Mumbai - followed by a range of project-based work placements in social enterprises. Reimagining India seeks to highlight India's status as a re-emerging economy of immense global significance, thereby raising students' awareness of the relevance of India to their lives, studies and future careers. It uses India's cities and villages as the classroom – including the political capital, New Delhi; the commercial capital, Mumbai; and the technological capital, Bangalore.

Lincoln University	Asian Agribusiness Summer School: Indonesia	15 candidates to undertake a 4-week Summer School, Airlangga, Brawijaya and Bogor Agriculture Universities, Indonesia. Trip will provide students with an opportunity to place their agribusiness theory into a real Asian context and learn first-hand about Asian business practice and culture.
Massey University	Internship Program, Tokyo, Japan	5 candidates to undertake an 8-week internship programme in Osaka, Japan. Students will be placed in industries in the local community to gain global business experience.
Lincoln and Massey	Agribusiness Programme, South Korea	15 candidates will have the opportunity to place their agribusiness theory into a real Asian context. In particular, this 4-week programme will balance social/cultural activities and formal lectures and provide students with international linkages in agribusiness.
Wintec	Study and Internship Programme at Hanbat University, South Korea	15 candidates will be enrolled full time for 15 weeks in the following papers: - International Business - Global Enterprise - Business Communication - Management of Technology They will have the opportunity to study the comparative situations between Korea's economy including world trends and NZ's economic backgrounds and situations.
Lincoln University	Asian Agribusiness Summer School - Thailand	15 candidates will undertake a 6-week agribusiness summer school in Thailand. Students will spend the first three weeks in Kasetsart University, Bangkok campus (KUB) and the last three weeks in Kasetsart University, Kasetsart University, Sriracha campus (KUS). The students will learn Thai language, culture and business practice. During this time students will interact with KUB and KUS students who have strong interests in studying in New Zealand, attend guest lecturers given by prominent industry leaders, field visits (such as, Phatumtanee Rice Research Center, Bang Nam Peung Floating Market, C.P. Thai Rice Co., Ltd. (Nakhon Luang), Dairy Farming Promotion Organization of Thailand (Saraburi), and Organic Rice Farm
University of Canterbury	Internship Programme to Thailand and Vietnam	8 candidates will undertake a 6-week UC Thailand Internship Programme provides them with an international educational experience that combines professional work experience with an intensive cultural immersion in Thailand and an education visit to Vietnam. The students' intern in a Bangkok business or organisation, where they gain a unique international work experience, develop professional work skills and learn to engage with a range of cultural expectations. The students also visit businesses, NGO's and significant social and cultural sites across Thailand and Vietnam, as well as the New Zealand embassies in Bangkok and Hanoi. The students are based at Mahidol University, Bangkok, where they engage with faculty and students and participate in student life on campus.
Otago Polytechnic	Study Tour and Internship Placement: Tourism and Hospitality Management in Central Vietnam	10 candidates will undertake a programme exploring the development of tourism and hospitality industry in the area and to build networks and friendships with personnel involved in the industry. The programme will include up to 2 weeks of placements with local or international companies operating in and around Da Nang. Internships will be available in three sectors: Tourism-related entrepreneurial organisations International Hotels (4 and 5 star) Event management organisations
