Summer Programs:</b> International Students are welcome to participate in multidisciplinary short courses offered in the Summer Term (June-July).</li><li><b>4. Spanish Program for Foreigners – “Vive Español”:</b> To improve and enrich the communicative competences in Spanish and intercultural competence for foreign students.</li><li><b>5. <b>Visa requirements</b>	<p><b>For all programs:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If the stay is less than 180 days, New Zealand Citizens (Students) are entitled to enter the country with a PIP-2 permission. This Permit of Stay will allow students an initial 90 days of permanence in Colombia. Prior to the expiration date, students must renew the Permit of Stay (PIP-2) for another 90 days. This will cost around USD 30 approx.</li> <li>• If the stay is more than 180 days, New Zealand Citizens (Students), should apply for a Visitors Visa (Visa-V).
