Visa requirements	 For all programs: If the stay is less than 180 days, New Zealand Citizens (Students) are entitled to enter the country with a PIP-2 permission. This Permit of Stay will allow students an initial 90 days of permanence in Colombia. Prior to the expiration date, students must renew the Permit of Stay (PIP-2) for another 90 days. This will cost around USD 30 approx. If the stay is more than 180 days, New Zealand Citizens (Students), should apply for a Visitors Visa (Visa-V).
