- c) Performance indicators for the planned activities, indicating the expected results;
- d) Provide a description of each candidate's contribution to the mission, explaining their expertise to carry out the foreseen activities;
- e) Describe any foreseen actions adding to the impact of the exchange for the host institution in New Zealand and for the host institution in the State of São Paulo, e.g., by means of seminars, short courses, etc;
- f) Description of how the Principal Investigator/s in São Paulo and at the New Zealand university intend to prepare a joint research project, resulting from the exchange activities developed from the proposal submitted in this Call, to be submitted to research funding agencies accessible in their regions in order to create a medium to long-term collaboration (up to one page).
