

Expression of Interest: Simulated Classroom at the Bangkok New Zealand Education Fair in Thailand – August 2018

Proposal information

The simulated classroom will target “high school”, “English language” and “undergraduate/foundation” audiences, which form part of the key target sectors in Thailand. The lessons will be staged in a room adjacent to each education fair and will be set up to replicate the look and feel of a modern NZ classroom. The simulated classroom would host up to 25 students along with seating space for parents, agent representatives and media.

This year there will be four 45 -minute classroom sessions over the course of the day. The four sessions will cover all levels and age ranges (12-20), so the lessons should be planned with this in mind.

The selected teacher will be representing New Zealand and not just the school they are associated with. There should be no reference to the school during the lesson and no school branding in the classroom.

What ENZ will cover:

- Accommodation costs (including breakfast) for the nights prior to and of the education fair.
- Promotional activities before, during and after the fair.
- Simulated classroom venue and equipment costs.

We would also consider providing funding towards international and internal economy class airfares where required, although would prioritise proposals where schools and institutions are funding these flight costs

Proposal Submission

We seek your proposals to co-invest with ENZ in this activity as part of NZ Education Fair in Bangkok in August 2018. If you are interested in submitting a proposal to us, please send your submission by email to: sam.heeney@enz.govt.nz no later than **5pm Monday 2nd July 2018.**

Your proposal should outline:

1. A one-page lesson plan for the 45-minute class (the same lesson plan will be used for all sessions) that showcases New Zealand’s unique learning style. As an alternative, or in addition to the written plan, a short video (up to 2 minutes) that showcases the lesson plan can also be submitted.

2. A CV or LinkedIn profile link to the CV of the teacher to give the lesson. We are seeking dynamic and enthusiastic teacher/ instructor who can act as an ambassador of New Zealand's innovative teaching style and can engage easily with a non-English speaking audience.
3. Confirmation that those costs not being met by ENZ, including but not limited to, airport transfers and meals, will be self-funded by the appointed teacher/school, as well as the contribution the school would make to transport costs.

Selection will be complete by **Monday 9th July 2018**.
